50/50 HOUSE RULES - 2017

WLSA President and Director in charge of Gaming as named on Licence, as well as System Administrator, will not be permitted to purchase 50/50 tickets.

Purchasers and sellers must be **19+** .

Ticket prices: **3 for \$5, 10 for \$10, 30 for \$20**, and will be **cash** only.

Ticket buyers receive a single printed receipt listing all of the numbers associated with the purchased tickets. The corresponding individual tickets are printed electronically and placed into the draw bin. One ticket is printed and placed in the bin for each ticket purchased.

Ticket sales occur at the Williams Lake Stampede grounds only.

Tickets will be available for sale one to one and a half hours prior to Rodeo Performances, and will end during the Team Roping event. **Draw will be made during the Bull Riding event.** A random ticket is drawn from the ticket draw bin by an individual who has not purchased a ticket.

Winning numbers will be shown on the big scoreboard screen, and will also be announced from the announcer's booth. In the case of a discrepancy between the announced number and the actual number – the actual number will be considered to be the valid winning ticket. **Winning ticket numbers will be posted at the Grandstand office.**

If the drawn winner does not come forward within **one hour of the end** of the Rodeo Performance, the entire purse will carry forward to the next Rodeo Performance. On the fifth and final Rodeo Performance, if a winner does not come forward within **10 minutes of the draw**, the number will be re-drawn, until a winner is identified. Winners will present themselves to the grandstand office behind the grandstand to **pick up their winnings**. Winnings will be paid out by **cheque** dated Tuesday, July 4, 2017.

If there is a problem with the ERS system prior to the start of ticket sales, the game will cease. If there is a problem during ticket sales, every effort will be made to commence the game, or for complete failure, tickets returned for refund. If the WLSA is able to verify that all tickets purchased prior to the suspension of ticket sales have been printed and placed in the draw bin, the draw will proceed and a winner will be announced.

Should there be a system error, and a duplicate number results in two winners presenting tickets, the prize will be split, an investigation commenced, and a report made to the Gaming Policy and Enforcement Branch. The Williams Lake Stampede Association shall not be liable at any time for any errors, system malfunctions or decisions made in connection with the administration of the 50/50 program.

Any complaints will be brought to the WLSA director in charge of gaming, at the grandstand office, and in turn brought to the board, if necessary, for resolution.
